## **Extra parking on cards for Rush/Lusk train station - Kennedy**

FIANNA FAIL'S North Dublin TD Michael Kennedy has called on Fingal County Council to look favourably on a planning application lodged by Iarnród Éireann to build nearly 200 parking spaces at Rush/Lusk train station.

Deputy Kennedy said: "After working with Iarnród Éireann on this issue, I have learned that a planning application has been recently submitted to the council for the construction of 199 new parking spaces – bringing the total to 359."

"If approved, the project will be completed by the middle of 2008 whilst further plans exist to expand the car park even more if related land deals prove successful."

"The application is currently being considered by the Planning Department of Fingal County Council and I would urge officials to consider the hundreds of commuters whose lives have been adversely affected by the rarity of spaces in the existing car park of Rush/Lusk Train Station car park."

"I welcome any development of this car park, big or small, and I am also calling on Iarnród Éireann to carry-on with their work as soon as possible and continue to deliver as best a service as possible to the people of North Dublin."
