Jobs boost for North Dublin – Kennedy

AN IMPORTANT jobs boost is on the way for Swords and the whole North County Dublin area thanks to a move by AIB to create 260 new jobs at the Airside Retail Park, Fianna Fail Deputy Michael Kennedy said today (November 06, 2007)

Deputy Kennedy said: “I am delighted to have spoken to officials at AIB who informed me that the new jobs will come in the form of customer service staff and will be based at Lakeview House at Airside. The bank is setting up a new customer call centre which will act as a support service to AIB’s retail section.”

“Whilst recruitment is already under way, I have been assured that efforts will be made to match local people’s skills with available job opportunities at the new centre. The jobs are expected to be created from April of next year.”

“The fact that Swords can continue to attract a high profile companies and employers - which require a specialised workforce - shows that we can compete with any area when it comes to attracting companies which provide quality jobs.”

“I think with the advent of the Metro North and the continued development of Dublin Airport, that the level of commercial investment in Swords and the whole North County area will continue to grow, and I will continue to lobby in the Dail for constant investment in our area,” concluded Deputy Michael Kennedy.
