Remedial works due for Mourne View Estate – Kennedy
New window, doors and central heating for Skerries estate's social houses

DUBLIN NORTH Deputy Michael Kennedy (FF) has welcomed Fingal County Council's move to implement a major home improvement project in the Mourne View estate in Skerries.

Deputy Kennedy said: "I have been dealing with a number of residents in the estate and have become concerned with the state of the windows and doors, and with the fact that many of the social houses are in need of insulation repairs and central heating."

"Following these representations, I can reveal that the council is now in the advanced stages of planning for a major remedial works project, which is to begin as soon as possible."

"Under the terms of the scheme, all windows and doors are to be replaced. Central heating is to be provided, along with attic insulation and ventilation."

"In addition to this, all doors and windows will be replaced."

"The council could not give me a commencement date for these works, as the plan is currently with the county architects, before going to tender – however, I am calling on Fingal to expedite the remedial works scheme so residents have the benefit of the improvements," concluded Deputy Kennedy.
