Safe and secure: Chapel Farm railings and playground on the way – Kennedy

RAILINGS AND a playground for Chapel Farm, Lusk are setting the agenda for meetings between Fingal County Council and Manor Park Homes, Deputy Michael Kennedy has revealed.

Deputy Kennedy said: "I have learned that the council is to meet with the developer of Chapel Farm to discuss the large open space in front of the estate with a view to progressing plans for the development of a playground and erection of railings along the stream on the site."

"There is an urgent need to advance plans for this open space area in this estate; plans which date back to 2003/04 under the planning permission for the estate. A playground would prove to be an enormous boost to the area, which is mainly populated by young families and I have been assured by the council's Parks Department that plans are ongoing for a playground on the site."

"There are also serious concerns about public safety in relation to a stream which runs through the open space, and which is currently unguarded."

"The council has the power to enforce the conditions of the planning permission for the area, which provided for the railings alongside the stream as well as the provision of a playground," concluded Deputy Kennedy.
